Dr. Rebecca Isbell is a motivational speaker, prolific writer, and consultant in early childhood education. She served as the Director of the Center of Excellence in Early Childhood Learning and Development and Professor of Early Childhood Education at East Tennessee State University, Johnson City, Tennessee where she was honored as an "Outstanding Teacher." She is the author of thirteen books and numerous articles related to creativity, learning environments, play, literacy, the arts, and child development. She is the author of *Creativity and Arts with Young Children* (3rd edition), a textbook that is widely used in early childhood classes. Other best-selling books include: *The Complete Book of Learning Centers* (Revised) and *Real Classroom Makeovers*. Her most recent book is *Nurturing Creativity: An Essential Mindset for Young Children's Learning* by NAEYC and published in English and Chinese.

Isbell has presented **Keynotes and Featured Sessions** throughout the United States from Alaska to New York, to Texas and California. She has spoken at **International Meetings** in **Denmark, Singapore, China, Canada, Saudi Arabia, and India.** Her sessions, **both in-person and virtual**, have been shared in small and large events, state, regional, national and international conferences, and include award celebrations.

Isbell has years of **diverse experiences in the field of early childhood** including: teacher of young children (2-8), director of a lab school, music teacher (k-5), coordinator of gifted/talented, early childhood program chair, supervisor of early childhood student teachers, professors, and program developer of BA, MA, MS, and PhD in Early Childhood Education.
